JEFFERSON'S MONTICELLO, by HOWARD ADAMS / ABBEVILLE, 1983

An architectural monograph on the house and grounds. Coffee table, in color with historical black&white photos and drawings.

COLONIAL WILLIAMSBURG, by PHIL KOPPER / ABRAMS, 1986

A major coffee table compendium and history covering every thing from major buildings to collections to gardens and outlying grounds.

MARY EMMERLING'S AMERICAN COUNTRY SOUTH, by Mary Emmerling
/ CLARKSON POTTER, 1989

One of the author's American Country series dedicated to the deep South. It contains work from the Shakers in Tennessee to early Victorian houses in Mobile, Alabama to the more modest aspects of life in the low country.

FLOWERS REDISCOVERED, by MADDERLAKE / STEWART, TABORI, & CHANG, 1985

A primer on modern and looser styles of flower arranging for the grandest of parties to your everyday kitchen table.

TRADE SECRETS, by MADDERLAKE / CLARKSON POTTER, 1994

More flower arranging, expanded to include roadside finds and many fieldflowers in season. Mostly photographed in Europe.

LEE BAILEY'S NEW ORLEANS, by LEE BAILEY / CLARKSON POTTER, 1993

A coffee table cookbook done in collaboration with Ella Brennan of the Commander's Palace Brennans. Photographed in 20 houses in the Garden District and the French Quarter showing snippets of architecture and details of interest that gives it a distinct New Orleans feeling.

LEE BAILEY'S LONG WEEKENDS, by LEE BAILEY / CLARKSON POTTER, 1994

More of the same, as above, photographed in weekend spots around the country from Dorset, Vermont to Orcas Island, Washington.

CALLAWAY GARDENS: LEGACY OF A DREAM / CALLAWAY EDITIONS, 1995

The other part of this resort from the golf and tennis. Azalea hillsides in spring, nature trails, wildlife, living butterfly collections and exotic plant specimens are featured, as well as the victory garden of TV fame.

FROM MY CHATEAU KITCHEN by ANNE WILLAN / CLARKSON POTTER, 2000

The kitchen in question is the author's cooking school "La Varenne" in Burgundy, France. More than a cookbook it is a story of her life there as an Englishwoman engaging life and French idiosyncrasies in the countryside. The photographs depict the region, the food, and the chateau itself in different seasons.

A reworking of the 1986 book of the same name. Includes many changes in decor from new research, and more about slave life in colonial times.

A story of gardening clubs and the women's beautification movement of the 20's and 30's as revealed in the history of writer Eudora Welty and her mother's garden.

EAT DRINK DELTA by Susan Puckett / University of Georgia Press 2013

A hungry Traveler's journey through the Mississippi Delta, the soul of the South.
